

Your Guide To Florida's School Choice Options

PEP PROGRAM



The Personalized Education Program is available to Florida students not enrolled in public school or a Home Education Program, through the Florida Tax Credit Scholarship Program. It provides an average of \$8,000, with scholarships ranging from \$6,900 to \$9,500, placed in an education savings account (ESA). These funds can be used for private school tuition, homeschooling, tutoring, instructional materials, and more.

UNIQUE ABILITIES

The scholarship for students with unique abilities provides an average of \$10,000 in financial assistance. Families receive an Education Savings Account (ESA), allowing them to direct funds toward approved programs and providers, including private schools, therapies, specialists, curriculum, and technology. It is available to students from age 3 through grade 12 or up to age 22 with a qualifying diagnosis.

PRIVATE SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP



The Florida Tax Credit (FTC) Scholarship and Family Empowerment Scholarship for Educational Options (FES-EO) offer an average of \$8,000 in financial assistance for private school tuition and related fees. These scholarships are available to all Florida students eligible for K-12 public schools, regardless of household income.

NEW WORLDS SCHOLARSHIP

The New Worlds Scholarship Accounts provide support for VPK and K-5 public school students struggling with reading or math. Students receive an education savings account (ESA) that can be used for tutoring, after-school and summer programs, instructional materials, and curriculum. The scholarship amount varies depending on the school year. Funds are directed toward educational expenses to help students become stronger learners.
